Located at A G Gillon Oval and members of the Yarra Junior Football League, our growing club offers opportunities for boys and girls to play in teams from U8 through to U17.5 Boys (Colts) and U18 Girls (Youth Girls). In 2022 we were able to field 16 teams with approximately 350 players. Tremendous growth that started with a single team when the club was founded in 2010.

To support this growth the club has opportunities in 2 key roles as outlined below.

U17.5 Coach (Colts) BJFC.

Applications are sought for the position of Colts Coach Brunswick Junior Football Club.

The appointment is for an initial 2 year term with annual reviews.

Responsibilities will include but not limited to;

- Coaching the club's top age Boys team – The Colts being under 17.5 years.
- Motivate the team with a positive attitude to training and game play that leads to on field success
- Instil the values of the BJFC
- Working with The Director of Coaching to create, maintain and develop a Coaching Program and game day strategy for all BJFC Coaches.
- Create and manage preseason and season training programs
- Working closely with the Under 14, 15 & 16 Boys Coaches to ensure a consistent development program from U14 to Colts.
- Working closely with the Brunswick Senior Football Club to ensure a strong connection and progression from Brunswick Junior to Men's Senior Football Club.



Director of Coaching BJFC.

Applications are sought for the position of Director of Coaching Brunswick Junior Football Club.

The appointment is for an initial 2 year term with annual reviews.

Responsibilities will include but not limited to;

- To create, maintain and develop a Coaching Program for all BJFC Coaches.
 - This component would be in conjunction with the Club's Colts Coach
 - This will include attention to the specific requirements relating to the girl's program.
 - Have a major focus on player retention
 - Create and manage preseason and season training programs relevant for teams in each age group
- Instil the values of the BJFC across all teams.
- Be involved in coach recruiting.
- To be available to attend training sessions each week to ensure all teams are visited a minimum of 3 times in the year. 1 in preseason, 1 in term 1 and 1 in term 2.
- Attend games to monitor the implementation and adoption of game plan strategy
- Where required in age groups from U13 Mixed up, participate in the club streaming process.
- Arrange a minimum of 4 group sessions throughout the season for coaches information and feedback. Nominally these would be in the preseason, after team grading, mid season and end of season.
- To evaluate and if appropriate implement and manage external coaching support and/or player development programs
- Working closely with the Brunswick Senior Football Club to ensure a strong connection and progression from Brunswick Junior to Men's and Women's Senior Football Club.
- Establish and maintain strong relationships with all stakeholders - YJFL, NAB League, parents, football partners, AFL/AFLW clubs.
