If a player/official wishes to accept the set penalty offered the club secretary must contact the Football Operations Manager, no later than 4pm on the second day following the match for approval. If the report is not requested to be heard by a tribunal by any party noted below (umpire / club secretary / official) or the Football Operations Manager, the player is automatically to be given the prescribed set penalty.
